Crisis Intervention Programs in Franklin County

CONNECT

- > CONNECT is a free, confidential, 24-hour emergency evaluation and referral service provided by the Carilion Clinic.
- > CONNECT is staffed by psychiatric nurses and clinical social workers.
- > Common symptoms include emotional problems like depression, anxiety, or rage. Behavioral issues, such as substance abuse, may be part of the picture as well.
- > The initial call does not provide treatment or therapy of any kind. It is simply a way to determine the best treatment options.
- > When necessary, CONNECT will contact a psychiatrist to admit the patient to the hospital.
- > CONNECT can perform emergency psychiatric assessments at Carilion New River Valley Medical Center during normal business hours and at Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital 24 hours a day.

Piedmont Community Services

- > Local community services board providing immediate crisis intervention, in and out of hospital.
- > Crisis Assessment done at Piedmont or at a hospital to get further help or address situation.
- > Crisis stabilization, like a short term outpatient style; catered for those seeking or needing immediate attention.
- > Walk-in and phone-in psychiatric evaluations are available.
- > Piedmont does accept people who don't have insurance, and do not require money up front. Sliding scale payment is available.
- > For referrals after business hours, call CONTACT. Piedmont workers are available during normal business hours (8:30 A.M. 5:00 P.M.).

CONTACT (Emergency crisis line)

- > 24/7 after-hours crisis services that connects them to emergency psychiatric services.
- > CONTACT pages a worker from Piedmont Community Services and puts them in touch with the client to assess what psychiatric services are needed.
- > CONTACT can refer clients to other services for shelter, psychiatry, counseling, etc.
- > CONTACT also offers a reassurance program where a client can request to have CONTACT call them as many times as they want throughout the day to check on them.
