Call to Report Abuse

Contact the Franklin County DSS CPS intake worker at (540) 483-9247 option 4, the Virginia Department of Social Services 24 hour Child Abuse Hotline at (800) 552-7096, or any Law Enforcement Agency at 911. You are not required to provide proof. Anyone who makes a good faith report based on reasonable grounds is immune from prosecution. If the abuse occurred within the past 120 hours, a medical evaluation by a Forensic Nurse Examiner/ Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner is available by going to the Emergency Department at Carilion Franklin Memorial Hospital (540-489-6439).
